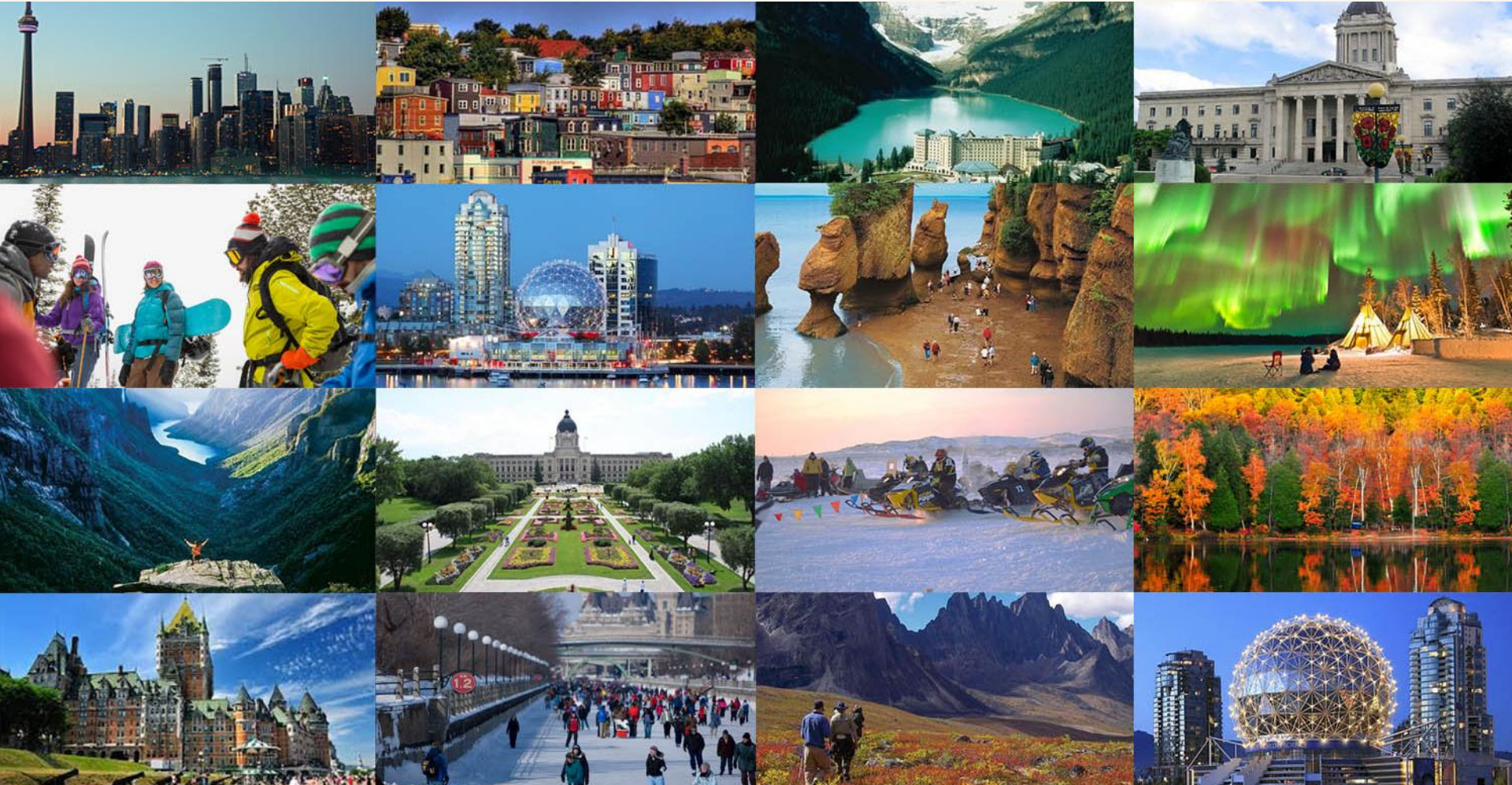

Study Permits

- You need a study permit to study in Canada for six months or longer
- You need the following documents to apply:
 - Proof of acceptance
 - Valid passport
 - Proof of financial support
 - Letter of explanation
- There are two ways to apply:
 - Online
 - On paper

www.EduCanada.ca

Find a university or college program:

Search by field of study, language of study, program level or location

Contact the Canadian institution directly to get information on:

- Their specific entry requirements for an international student and the application deadlines **Remember:** *each education institution in Canada sets its own entry requirements*
- The program costs and information on living expenses:
This estimate includes tuition/program fees, books/supplies, groceries, local public transport and miscellaneous costs, accommodation options
